**READINGS FOR SUNDAY APRIL 10, 2022
PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD**

Procession with the Palms: Luke 19: 28-40
First Reading: Isaiah 50: 4-7
Second Reading: Philippians 2: 6-11
Gospel: Luke 22: 14-23: 56 or 23: 1-49

FOCUS: Stay close to Jesus, trusting God, at the foot of the cross.

The passion of Christ reveals God's heart in concrete reality. We must step into this narrative. We want to be Simon who aided Jesus in time of need. We are Barabbas - deserving death - granted life and freedom. As Christians, our hearts are made for God - we are invited to remember the events of Palm Sunday and be present with Jesus during his passion.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the introductory reading from Luke's Gospel, Jesus enters Jerusalem as the crowd praises God. The prophet Isaiah foretells God's servant who hears and speaks his word and does not turn back from suffering. Paul writes to the Philippians, praising Jesus, who humbled himself and was exalted by God. In the Gospel, Jesus shares a Passover supper with his disciples, where he gives them bread and wine- which is his body and blood - to eat and drink. Afterwards, he prays at the Mount of Olives and then is betrayed, tried, and crucified.
